Pedagogical creativity means creativity, initiative, pedagogical perseverance and the path leading to innovation in the teacher's rise from the skill levels. Pedagogical tact (tact) in the system of pedagogical skills is characterized as a measure, norm and limit of the teacher's pedagogical purposeful, useful, valuable actions. Pedagogical technique is an organizational form of the teacher's activity, which embodies didactic, organizational, constructive, communicative skills in teaching and influencing students.
