When using the "brainstorming" method, the number of students should not exceed 10-15.

The method of "general mental attack"

The method helps to create conditions for students to come up with new ideas. Includes every 5 or 6 students one of the group members will inform you after the various tasks or creative tasks that need to be solved positively within 15 minutes are solved positively within the set time. The information provided by the group (assignment or solution to a creative task) is discussed and evaluated by the teacher and other group members. At the end of the lesson, the teacher announces the answers that are considered the best and most unique among the solutions to the given task or creative tasks. During the training, the activities of the group members will be

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evaluated according to their level of participation. Pedagogical technology, in its essence, is organized by forms, methods and tools, which increases the effectiveness of pedagogical activity and determines the interaction between teachers. In addition, it provides students with a thorough knowledge of the subject. Develops students' independent, free and creative thinking skills.
