PROBLEMS OF TRAINING AND TRAINING OF PEDAGOGICAL PERSONNEL IN THE PRESCHOOL EDUCATION SYSTEM

This, in turn, should be done by conducting scientific research in the field of education and putting them into practice. It is necessary to strengthen cooperation between educational institutions and research centers, develop programs aimed at improving the professional qualifications of educators.[3]

Therefore, it is necessary to create systems that encourage educators to regularly update their knowledge and skills. Mentoring, advanced training courses, seminars and trainings occupy an important place within these systems.
